GUIDELINES FOR AWARDING GRACE MARKS FOR SPORTS ACTIVITIES/ ADVENTURE SPORTS/ ARTS FESTIVEL COMPETITION AND N.S.S. ACTIVITIES

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- 1. Sports/Arts Festival competition and participation in N.S.S. activities during the period of a semester will be considered for awarding gracemarks in that semester.
- 2. Gracemarks shall be awarded for the following Sports Activities/Arts Festival Competition/N.S.S. activities.

i. Sports

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- a. Only specified intercollegiate competitions conducted by the Department of Physical Education of the University.
- b. Inter University competitions organized by the All Indian Universities.
- c. Representation in Kerala State Sports Council approved/recognised associations competitions.
- d. Only a single highest achievement during the period of a semester will be considered for awarding grace marks.
- ii. Arts
 - a. Only intercollegiate competitions conducted by Cochin University Students Union.
 - b. Zonal Competitions and National Competitions conducted All Indian Universities
 - c. Only a single highest achievement during the period of a semester will be considered forwarding grace marks.
- iii. N.S.S. Activities
 - a. Participation in N.S.S. Camps at state and National level approved by NSS programme Co-ordinator of the University.
 - b. Eligible for only single highest percentage of grace marks.
- 3. The total grace marks from all categories put together, awarded in a semester will be limited to 15%.
- 4. Only bonafide and regular students as certified by the Principal of the College concerned/Head of the Department/Division concerned/ Directors of the School concerned are eligible for the award of gracemarks.
- 5. No gracemarks shall be awarded for supplementary examinations unless the student fails to attend the regular examination due to camps/ tournaments etc..
- 6. Percentage of gracemarks to be awarded to each paper shall be based on the maximum marks of each paper.
- 7. Grace marks shall be added to external marks only.
- 8. No gracemarks shall be awarded for the paper (s) if the student fails to score more than 20% marks or does not write the examination.
- 9. Moderation shall be effected after the gracemarks have been added to the original marks of the student.
- 10. The gracemarks awarded shall not be shown separately in the marklist.
- 11. The Grace marks awarded shall not be considered for ranking.

- 12. Grace Marks once awarded will not be reopened again.
- 13. Students may apply for gracemarks in the prescribed application form to the Principal/Director/Head of the Institutions/ Schools/ Departments before 1st April in case of even semesters and before 1st November in case of odd semesters. The Principal/Director/Head may consolidate the same in the prescribed form and forward the same to the competent authority concerned within one week as detailed below:

i)	Sports activities	-	Assistant Director, Department of Physical Education, CUSAT.
ii)	Cultural/Literary/Arts	-	The Treasurer,
	Festival Winners	*	Cochin University Students Union

iii) N.S.S. Activities

N.S.S. Co-ordinator, CUSAT.

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The above authorities may forward the applications with specific recommendation to the Controller of Examinations within 15 days.

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
